WELCOME

At Splash Lagoon, we are committed to providing all of our guests a safe, enjoyable, and memorable visit. Attractions may feature experiences some may find frightening, such as high speeds, sharp turns, sudden slopes, drops, twists, or other dynamic forces. Splash Lagoon follows all manufacture restrictions and recommendations. Please carefully review and consider the requirements and restrictions for our attractions listed in this Accessibility Guide and at the entrances to our attractions to determine if you or members of your party can safely participate. If you have any impairment or condition that would prevent you from properly using the seating and safety restraints or from following any safety requirement, DO NOT RIDE.

Guests who need accessibility information or an accommodation during their visit are invited to visit Guest Services.

This Rider Safety & Accessibility Guide provides information on the recommendations and restrictions for each attraction. Please read through this Guide to learn more about the services we provide and specific attraction information.

ATTRACTION ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAM

The Splash Lagoon Attraction Accessibility Program is designed to allow guests to participate in the enjoyment of our water park as much as possible. Each attraction has been evaluated for the criteria necessary for an individual to ride safely.

SAFETY WARNINGS

Before Experiencing an Attraction: Please Note All Safety Warnings – Both Verbal & Written – For Each Attraction

Pennsylvania Rider Safety Act No. 1994-58 requires that riders must obey all warnings and restrictions regarding rides and must behave in a manner that will not cause or contribute to injury of themselves or others. Failure to comply is cause for dismissal from the Park without refund.

Please note and comply with all written and verbal safety warnings and instructions for each attraction and follow all directions given by Splash Lagoon personnel, such as:

- Secure all loose articles (cell phones, keys, bags, wallets, beverage containers, and other items) or leave them with a non-rider.
- Please wait for all attractions to come to a complete stop before attempting to board.
- Please wait for the attraction to come to a complete stop before attempting to exit.
- Please exercise caution in boarding each attraction.
- Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on attractions. Revealing bathing suits, shorts with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentation, cutoffs, and jeans are not permitted.
- Keep all body parts (hands, arms, legs, long hair, etc.) inside the attraction unit at all times.
- Remain in the proper riding position and hold on until the ride comes to a complete stop.
- Failure to comply with safety warnings and instructions may result in guests being denied entrance to an attraction and/or removal from the water park with NO REFUND GIVEN.

Read all health and safety requirements for each attraction as they are not all the same. You know your physical conditions and limitations; Splash Lagoon and its team members do not. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, do not ride or participate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

First Aid

First Aid is located at the base of the stair nearest to the elevator. First Aid is staffed with First Aid certified personnel. If personnel are not present in First Aid, press the button to the left of the door to notify staff that first aid is needed.

Food & Beverage

Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is committed to helping our guests with food allergies make the best possible dining choice during their visit with the help of our dining guide and specialty food offerings. Guests can bring Epi-Pens into Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park.

While in the Park, our food and beverage staff will be more than happy to answer any questions our guests may have. We keep a list of ingredients at each location and our staff can supply guests with that information.

For Guests with a Hearing Impairment

If you are not able to hear attraction loading and unloading instructions, please notify the Lifeguard and/or Slide Attendant prior to boarding the attraction. Written attraction safety speeches/directions are available upon request of the Lifeguard and/or Slide Attendant.

Guests Accompanied by Service Animals

Service animals are welcome at Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park. Service animals are defined as dogs or miniature horses that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for, and to assist, people with disabilities. Dogs (or other animals) whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals and are not permitted at Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park. Service animals must remain on a leash or harness and/or under the control of their handler at all times and be house broken. If at any time a service animal demonstrates aggressive behavior towards other guests and employees, or displays other inappropriate or disruptive behavior, the guest will be directed to remove the service animal from Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park. The service animal relief area is located outside behind the FlowRider. Handlers of the animal are responsible for cleaning up after their animal. Service animals are not permitted to enter the water of any attraction. The animal's handler must remain with the animal at all time. Splash Lagoon employees are not permitted to take control of or responsibility of the service animal.

Oxygen Tanks/Devices

Due to dynamic forces and design of the attraction, portable oxygen tanks are not permitted on any Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park attractions.

Parking

Splash Lagoon provided accessible parking spaces, available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Pool Lift

Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park provides pool lifts for guests who are unable to use the steps to walk into the Activity Pool, Lazy River, and Lava Pool. Please speak with an Aquatic Supervisor, Zone Captain or First Aid Attendant for assistance. Zero-depth entry is available at Monkey Shine's Island Kid's Pool and Wild Wave Wave Pool.

Restrooms

Accessible bathroom and shower stalls are available in the *Men's and Women's Changing Rooms; Main Family Changing Rooms; Wave Pool/Surf Bar Men's and Women's Changing Room*. Family Changing/Bathrooms are located near *Monkey Shine's Island Kids Pool; Surf Bar; Treasure Island Arcade*.

Wheelchairs

Splash Lagoon does not provide or have the option to rent wheelchairs. Guests are permitted to bring their own manual wheelchair to use while in the park. Guests are able to bring their own aquatic wheelchair to use on the beach of the Wild Waters Wave Pool.

Retail

Surf shop personnel are available to ensure that items are accessible. Ask the Surf Shop Attendant for assistance in obtaining any hard-to-reach items.

Smoking

Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is a smoke-free facility, including any electronic smoking devices. Designated smoking areas are located on the *Sun Deck* and 20' on each side from the main entrance to Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Guests with Limb Differences

Please review the attraction requirements to ensure rider eligibility. Guests with limb differences should visit First Aid, as some of our attractions have specific natural limb requirements to ride safely.

Guests with Prostheses

Please review the attraction requirements to ensure rider eligibility. If permitted to ride, any guests with prosthetic devices will be required to ensure the device is properly attached and must have the ability to remain in the proper riding position throughout the attraction experience. On attractions where prosthetic limbs must be removed, certain hand, arm, leg, and joint elements are required to ride safely. Any prosthetic with exposed sharp adornments that may damage the slide must be removed and left with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon is not responsible for water damage to prostheses. If you have any questions, please speak with Aquatic Manager, Aquatic Supervisor or First Aid.

Casts or Braces

Please review the attraction requirements in the Attraction Information section to ensure rider eligibility. Casts or braces, are permitted in all pools and while riding in a single tube on Big Kahuna, Cyclone and Python Plunge. Casts and braces are not permitted on body slides and on double tubes. Splash Lagoon is not responsible for water damage to casts or braces. If in doubt about your ability to experience a ride safely, please consult with a Lifeguard/Slide Attendant or visit First Aid for further information.

Guests with Vision Disabilities

Many attractions can accommodate a guest with a white cane. The cane may need to be collapsed on some attractions, and all white canes must be free of any sharp adornments that may damage the slides. Please speak with an Aquatic Manager, Aquatic Supervisor or First Aid with any questions or for further assistance.

HEIGHT REQUIREMENTS AT A GLANCE

Height requirements are posted at each attraction. All guests must meet the height requirements.

Python Plunge	Guests between 40" and 48" must be accompanied by an adult riding in a double tube with the adult in the rear of the tube. Must be 48" or taller to ride alone. Guests under 40" tall are not permitted to ride.
Riptide Racer	Must not exceed 48" tall to ride.
Shark Attack	Must be 40" or taller to ride.
XD Dark Ride	No height requirement.
Tree Tops Ropes Course	No height requirement.
Typhoon Twister	Must be 36" or taller to ride.
Wild Waters Wave Pool	Guest under 48" must wear a Coast Guard approved lifejacket beyond the painted red line. Any weak swimmers are recommended to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket.

ATTRACTIONS

A description of each major attraction is arranged alphabetically below. Each description contains the height requirement, rider requirements, health recommendations, ride access, and sensory information specific to that attraction.

Adventure Bay/Coquí Crossing

Adventure Bay/Coquí Crossing is an open pool area featuring basketball hoops and lily pads. Adventure Bay/Coquí Crossing is accessible via stairs or a pool lift. Open swimming is not permitted in the Coquí Crossing (lily pad) area.

Height Requirement: Adventure Bay – No height requirement. Coquí Crossing – Guests unable to reach the rope netting above the lily pads must be assisted by an adult.

Rider Requirements: Guests must be able to swim or wear a lifejacket and be accompanied by an adult.

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 3 ½' to 4'

Ride Access: Access is available via stairs or pool lift. Guests will have to transfer to the stairs, lift, on their own or with the assistance of a companion. Please speak with an Aquatic Supervisor, Zone Captain or First Aid to obtain access to the pool lift.

Weight Limit: There is a 400lb. weight limit to use the lily pads.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted.

Sensory Information: Average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Big Kahuna

Big Kahuna is an enclosed tube slide that consists of twists and turns. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride. Big Kahuna is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a 3 ½' pool of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Riders must be able to swim. Riders need to transfer in and out of a tube. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are permitted on Big Kahuna.

Height Requirement: Guests between 40" and 48" must be accompanied by an adult riding in a double tube with the adult in the rear of the tube. Must be 48" or taller to ride alone. Guests under 40" tall are not permitted to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to sit in an upright-seated position. Riders must be able to grasp the handles throughout the entire ride with two functioning hands and brace with two functioning legs. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 3 ½'

Ride Access: Big Kahuna is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs. Riders with disabilities who wish to experience Big Kahuna must wait in line and carry the tube.

Weight Limit: There is a 250lb. weight limit on the single tubes and 400 lb. weight limit on the double tubes.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Black Hole

Black Hole is an enclosed body slide that consist of twists and turns. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride while in total darkness. Black Hole is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a runout of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: Must be 36" or taller to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine position. Riders must be able to clasp their hands together with two functioning hands and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: Slide runout.

Ride Access: Black Hole is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Coconut Fall Tree House

Coconut Falls Tree House features four slides (Black Hole, Maui Wowie, Riptide Race, Typhoon Twister), bridges and spray/water features with a giant tipping coconut bucket. Each water slide on the attraction has its own height and eligibility restriction found in this guide and at the entrance to the slide. Please ask a lifeguard for specific restrictions for each slide. Wheelchair access is available on the ground level of Coconut Falls Tree House.

Height Requirement: No height requirement. **Specific slides on Coconut Falls Tree House have height requirements.**

Rider Requirements: No rider requirements. **Specific slides on Coconut Falls Tree House have rider requirements.**

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: N/A.

Ride Access: Coconut Falls Tree House ground level is accessible via wheel chair. Coconut Falls Tree House structure is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit. **Specific slides on Coconut Falls Tree House have height requirements.**

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not recommended while participating. Food and drinks are not permitted. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Cyclone

Cyclone is an enclosed tube slide that consists of twists and turns, exiting into a bowl before ending in a pool. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride. Cyclone is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a 3 ½' pool of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Riders must be able to swim. Riders need to transfer in and out of a tube. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are permitted on Cyclone.

Height Requirement: Guests between 40" and 48" must be accompanied by an adult riding in a double tube with the adult in the rear of the tube. Must be 48" or taller to ride alone. Guests under 40" tall are not permitted to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to sit in an upright-seated position. Riders must be able to grasp the handles throughout the entire ride with two functioning hands and brace with two functioning legs. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 3 ½'

Ride Access: Cyclone is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs. Riders with disabilities who wish to experience Cyclone must wait in line and carry the tube.

Weight Limit: There is a 250lb. weight limit on the single tubes and 400 lb. weight limit on the double tubes.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Flow Rider

Flow Rider is a high dynamic wave simulator. This ride is a very strenuous ride with extremely turbulent moving water. Flow Rider is no accessible by wheelchair. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride. Riders must watch an instructional video and sign a waiver before riding.

Height Requirement: Must be 42" or taller to ride the body board. Must be 48" or taller to ride the standing board.

Rider Requirements: Must be able to swim in fast moving, turbulent water.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: N/A

Ride Access: Flow Rider is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device.

Weight Limit: There is a 300lbs. weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight; flashing lighting effects; above average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Hurricane Hole

Hurricane Hole is an enclosed body slide that consist of twists and turns, exiting into a bowl before ending in a 6' pool. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride while in total darkness. Hurricane Hole is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into 6' of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. This slide is only recommended for strong swimmers. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride. Glasses are not permitted on Hurricane Hole.

Height Requirement: Must be 48" or taller to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine position. Riders must be able to clasp their hands together with two functioning hands and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 6'

Ride Access: Hurricane Hole is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Kid's Froggy Splash Pad

Kid's Froggy Splash Pad is an open splash pad area featuring various spraying jets, a water curtain, and tipping buckets. Wheelchair access is available at Kid's Froggy Splash Pad.

Requirement: No height requirement.

Rider Requirements: No rider requirements.

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: N/A.

Ride Access: Wheelchair access is available at Kid's Froggy Splash Pad.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight, average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Kid's Treehouse (located in Monkey Shines Island)

Kid's Treehouse features two slides (orange double racer slides and blue tube body slide), spray/water features with a tipping coconut bucket. Each water slide on the attraction has its own height and eligibility restriction found in this guide and at the entrance to the slide. Please ask a lifeguard for specific restrictions for each slide.

Height Requirement: Must be under 48" to participate and ride the slides (orange double racer slides and blue tube body slide).

Rider Requirements: No rider requirements.

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: N/A (Kid's Treehouse is located in the middle of Monkey Shines Island, a 1 ½" pool).

Ride Access: Kid's Treehouse structure is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: There is a 220lbs. weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not recommended while participating. Food and drinks are not permitted. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Lava Pool Family Hot Tub

Lava Pool Family Hot Tub is a kept between 93°-97° hot tube for families. Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Prolonged exposure to chlorinated water may cause an adverse allergic skin reaction to guests with sensitive or dry skin. Guests should limit their time in the hot tub to 10-15 minutes. Lava Pool Family Hot Tub is not recommended for children under 6 years or age.

Height Requirement: No height requirement.

Rider Requirements: Each rider must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the seated position.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 3'

Ride Access: Access is available via stairs or pool life. Guests will have to transfer to the stairs, lift, on their own or with the assistance of a companion. Please speak with an Aquatic Supervisor, Zone Captain or First Aid to obtain access to the pool lift.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells; high temperatures

Maui Wowie

Maui Wowie is an open body slide that consist of twists and turns. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride. Maui Wowie is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a runout of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: Must be 36" or taller to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine position. Riders must be able to clasp their hands together with two functioning hands and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: Slide runout.

Ride Access: Maui Wowie is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Monkey Shines Island – Double Slide (Turquoise) and Twister Slide (Purple)

Monkey Shines Island is a wading pool with a zero-depth entrance featuring two slides (orange double slide) and purple twister slide), the Kid's Treehouse with two slides attached (reference Kid's Treehouse for the requirements). Each water slide has its own height and eligibility restriction found in this guide and at the entrance to the slide. Please ask a lifeguard for specific restrictions for each slide. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: No height requirement for the wading pool; Double Slide – No height requirement. Small children are permitted to ride in the lap of a parent; Twister Slide – Must be under 48" to ride.

Rider Requirements: No rider requirements to use the wading pool; **Double Slide (Turquoise)** – Rider should have the physical and cognitive abilities to remain in an upright, feet first, seated position throughout the course of the ride; **Twister Slide (Purple)** - Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine position. Riders must be able to clasp their hands together with two functioning hands and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 1 ½'

Ride Access: Monkey Shines Island wading pool is accessible via the zero-depth entry. Double Slide and Twister Slide are not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding Double Slide and Twister Slide. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Paradise Cove Adult Hot Tub

Paradise Cove Hot Tub is a kept between 95°-99° hot tub for adults. Prolonged exposure to chlorinated water may cause an adverse allergic skin reaction to guests with sensitive or dry skin. Guests should limit their time in the hot tub to 10-15 minutes. Guest under 21 years of age are not permitted in Paradise Cove Adult Hot Tub.

Height Requirement: No height requirement.

Rider Requirements: Each rider must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the seated position.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 3'.

Ride Access: Paradise Cove Adult Hot Tub is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the pool entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells; high temperatures

Python Plunge

Python Plunge is an enclosed tube slide that consists of twists and turns, exiting in a pool. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride. Python Plunge is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a 1 ½' pool of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Riders must be able to swim. Riders need to transfer in and out of a tube. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are permitted on Python Plunge.

Height Requirement: Guests between 40" and 48" must be accompanied by an adult riding in a double tube with the adult in the rear of the tube. Must be 48" or taller to ride alone. Guests under 40" tall are not permitted to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to sit in an upright-seated position. Riders must be able to grasp the handles throughout the entire ride with two functioning hands and brace with two functioning legs. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 1 ½'

Ride Access: Python Plunge is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs. Riders with disabilities who wish to experience Python Plunge must wait in line and carry the tube.

Weight Limit: There is a 250lb. weight limit on the single tubes and 400 lb. weight limit on the double tubes.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

Riptide Racer

Riptide Racer is a four-lane racing body slide for guests under 48" tall. Riptide Racer is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide lanes exit into a runout of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: Must be under 48" to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine or seating position facing forward. Riders must be able to cross their arms across the chest and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: Slide runout.

Ride Access: Riptide Racer is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: 220lbs.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Shark Attack

Shark Attack is an enclosed body slide that consist of twists and turns. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride while in darkness. Shark Attack is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a runout of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: Must be 40" or taller to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine position. Riders must be able to clasp their hands together with two functioning hands and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: Slide runout.

Ride Access: Shark Attack is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Low light/dark space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells.

The Lazy River

Riders in tubes experience slow, winding water on a river that passes through a waterfall corral reef. Water depth is 2 ½'. Riders must be able to swim. Weaker swimmers must wear a life jacket. Guests need to transfer in and out of a tube. Riders must remain on their tube. Each rider must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the seated position.

Height Requirement: No height requirement.

Rider Requirements: Each rider must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the seated position.

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: 2 ½'

Ride Access: Access is available via stairs or pool lift. Guests will have to transfer to the stairs, lift, on their own or with the assistance of a companion. Please speak with an Aquatic Supervisor, Zone Captain or First Aid to obtain access to the pool lift.

Weight Limit: There is a 250lb. weight limit on the single tubes and 400 lb. weight limit on the double tubes.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Typhoon Twister

Typhoon Twister is an open body slide that consist of twists and turns. Riders will experience strong acceleration and deceleration from the front, back, and sides during the ride. Typhoon Twister is not accessible by wheelchair; the queue for this attraction includes a flight of stairs. The slide exits into a runout of water and riders must immediately exit the pool after exiting. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all riders. Cut-off jeans and jeans,

attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Swim shoes are not permitted on this ride.

Height Requirement: Must be 36" or taller to ride.

Rider Requirements: Riders must exhibit independent posture control to remain in the supine or seating position facing forward. Riders must be able to cross their arms across the chest and cross their legs with two functioning legs to the ankles. Riders must be able to maintain posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movements including sudden accelerations, dramatic tilting, and jarring actions.

Health Recommendations: Do not ride if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; pregnancy; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Maximum Water Depth: Slide runout.

Ride Access: Typhoon Twister is not accessible by wheelchair or other mobility device. Non-ambulatory riders must enter through the ride entrance which includes a flight of stairs.

Weight Limit: 220lbs.

Loose Articles: Hand-held items are not permitted while riding. Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.

Sensory Information: Bright light/daylight space; average noise levels; potential to taste or accidentally swallow water; strong smells

Wild Waters Wave Pool

An approximately 200,00-gallon wave pool with realistic waves reaching up to 6' tall in water depths ranging from zero to five feet. Guests under 48" tall and weaker swimmers are required to wear life jackets beyond the 3" depth. Only appropriate swimwear is permitted on this attraction for all swimmers. Cut-off jeans and jeans, attire with rivets, snaps, zippers, metal ornamentations, shoes, sandals or footwear with buckles are not permitted. Guests utilizing ECVs and wheelchairs must transfer to an aquatic wheelchair to enter Wild Waves Wave Pool.

Height Requirement: Guests under 48" tall and weaker swimmers are required to wear life jackets beyond the 3" depth.

Rider Requirements: Riders must be able to maintain independent posture control while absorbing sudden and dramatic movement changes.

Health Recommendations: Not recommended to participate if you have any of these conditions: Recent injury or illness; heart condition; neck, back, or skeletal conditions; high blood pressure or hyper tension; under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Ride Access: Wild Waves Wave Pool is accessible via the zero-depth entry.

Weight Limit: No weight limit.

Loose Articles: Food and drinks are not permitted. Loose articles that cannot be secured must be kept with a non-rider or secured with a non-rider. Splash Lagoon Indoor Water Park is not responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged while you ride.
